CELL PHONE USE PERMISSION FORM

The Swain School is allowing 5th-8th grade students and their parents the convenience of students using cell telephones on campus. This is a unique opportunity that must not be abused. Our regulations are clear and must be observed for students to have this privilege.

- All students using a cell phone on campus must sign an agreement.
- All students using a cell phone on campus must sign an agreement.
- Students must seek permission from the supervising adult **each** time they use the phone.
- Phones are to be used only to resolve pick-up issues after after-school activities or to change plans when after-school activities are cancelled.
- Cell phones are to be used to make telephone calls only (no text messaging, photography, etc.).
- Any other use of the cell phone is at the discretion of the Division Director, not the student.
- Cell phones used or displayed improperly will be confiscated.
- Cell phones must be kept out of sight in a backpack within the student's locker.
- All cell phones must be on vibrate or silent at all times.

I understand and agree to abide by the regulations surrounding the use of cell phones by students at The Swain School. I also understand that should I violate our agreement that I will likely not be allowed to use a cell phone again, after review by the Division Director.
